Our new Lodge Pin is a shield with the Maryland Flag displayed prominently on the top to signify the state we are from. The Square and Compass to let all know we are Masons. The number "25" represents our lodge number and directly beneath it is our "Chartered 1797". Our lodge's name is prominently displayed underneath the Square and Compass, with our sister lodges Centre, Cassia and St John's framing the Chartered 1797. The pin has no individual name or year on it to allow the use of it for many years to come. This makes it a very unique and sought after pin, that many have already asked for that have seen it who are not members of our lodge. We will be presenting this pin to the men we have raised these past five years and for the men that we will be raising in the future.
